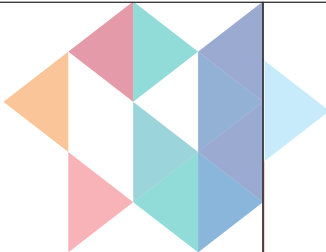
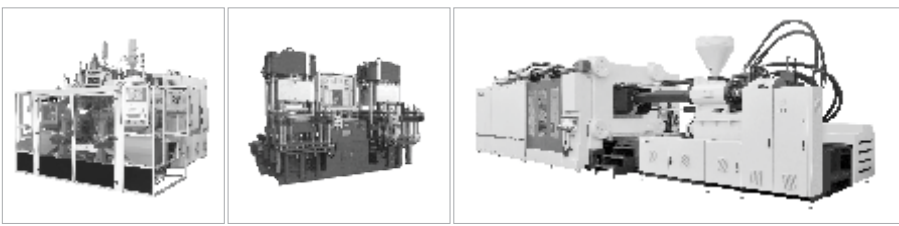

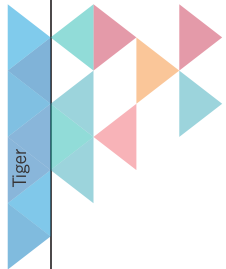

1. Achievements

PMMAI earned recognition as industry association of national status representing the interest of Plastics Machinery manufacturing sector of our country with the Department of

Heavy Industries, Ministry of Commerce, Ministry of Finance & Revenue, Department of Chemicals & Petrochemicals.

2. Progress made in matters of advocacy with Government

- Represented for Reversal of customs duty reductions on some categories of Plastics machinery which were agreed under FTA signed with South Korea, Malaysia, Vietnam, Philippines & Thailand.- We were heard, no results as yet.
- Requested to Not to agree customs duty reductions on plastics machinery under Free Trade Agreements (FTA) which Government would enter henceforth with different countries. We were heard and our request is honored in FTAs, subsequently signed.
- Represented seeking Customs duty reductions on technology components which we import to incorporate in our machines so that our input costs are reduced.- Our recommendation are analyzed and being considered in new budget.
- Represented to encourage exports by expanding Focus product and Focus Country schemes to the complete plastics machinery categories to avail benefits of the scheme. Our representation is accepted, being considered in new Exim policy.

3. PMMAI is one of the founder members of Capital Goods Skill Council (CGSC) a program initiated by DHI and FICCI for developing Skilled manpower for our sector.

4. Represented to DHI and Tariff Commission to Ban/ Discourage import of Used Machinery by Plastics Processors.- Tariff Commission conducted detailed study and have sent their advise in line with our request to DCPC.

5. Participated in preparation of comprehensive list of Plastics Machinery to be included for govt. assistance to

processors under Technology Up-gradation Fund (TUF).

6. PMMAI is actively working & supporting government's new initiatives of Make in India, Swachh Bharat and Skill development.

7. Progress made in Organisational activity.

a. PMMAI was started by about 13 members & now the organization has grown into 85 members.

b. Conducted several interactive sessions with industry members and processors through Workshops and Seminars .

- Industry growth through domestic as well as export market development
- Promote interest of all stakeholders
